This workbook is an aid for the online classes with Tiaan Nel. You need the classes for the pronunciation and many valuable tips.

From lesson 601 we want to make time after each lesson to practice speaking in small groups. The lesson will start with Tiaan revising that which we will be using in our dialogues as well as teaching us new words. Please use these worksheets to get yourself ready for the practical lessons. Read the dialogues, write your own sentences and then practice what you have read and studied in the small groups.

This week our focus will be on words, questions and phrases we have learnt in lessons 101 – 108. You may want to look at the screenshots or workbooks from those lessons again, but you don't have to. With these practice sheets you will be able to refresh your memory as well.

Dialogue 1 - Introduce yourself

Hello! Who are you? (Addressing a man)	שלום! מי אתה?
I am Tiaan. Who are you? (Speaking to a woman)	אני טיאן. מי את?
I am Mari. Pleasant to meet!	אני מרי. נעים מאוד.

You can also ask these questions when in small groups of three people or more:

Who is he?	מי הוא?
Who is she?	מי היא?
Who are you (plural)?	מי אתם / מי אתן?
Who are they?	מי הם / מי הן?

After playing around with the above dialogues, take turns introducing yourselves. Use sentences like these:

I am Tiaan, I am a man.	אני טיאן. אני איש.
I am from South Africa.	אני מדרום אפריקה.
I am 30 years old.	אני בן שלושים.
I have a beautiful wife and three good sons.	יש לי אשה יפה ושלושה בנים טובים.
At the moment I live in South Africa.	עכשיו אנחנו גרים בדרום אפריקה.
Gilah lives in Dusseldorf in Germany.	גילה גרה בדוסלדורף בגרמניה.
I like to fly to Israel.	אני אוהב לטוס לישראל.
I work on Zoom. I am teacher for Hebrew.	אני עובד בזום. אני מורה לעברית.
I believe in Yeshua the Messiah.	אני מאמין בישוע המשיח.
I speak Hebrew.	אני מדבר עברית.

Useful words:

student	תלמיד, תלמידה
I am learning Hebrew.	אני לומד עברית.
I speak a little Hebrew.	אני מדבר קצת עברית.

Your language:	
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You may want to use these questions to get the conversations going:

How are you?	מה שלומך? / מה שלומך?
Goodbye	להתראות
Where are you from?	מאיפה אתה / את / אתם / אתן?
Where do you live?	איפה אתה גר?
Where do you work?	איפה אתה עובד?

Remember to conjugate the verbs! I have written most of the sentences in the male singular form.
