Why?	למה?
<b>ANSWER POSSIBILITIES:</b>	
Why not?	למה לא?
Just because!	פכה!
I don't know! (m)	אני לא יודע!
I don't know! (f)	אני לא יודעת!
because...	כי...
because I...	כי אני...
Because of...	בגלל...

**GRAMMAR:**

Sentence structure when using the question word 'Why?':

Why + Personal Pronoun + verb (correct form) + extra words

למה + אתה / את + אוקב / לומד / גר

למה אתה אוקב קפה?

**EXAMPLES:**

לְמָה אַתְּ שָׂם?	כִּי אֲנִי לֹא פֹה!
לְמָה אַתְּ גָּרָה בְּדֵרוֹם אֶפְרַיִקָה?	לְמָה אַתָּה לֹא גָר בְּדֵרוֹם אֶפְרַיִקָה?
לְמָה אַתָּם לֹא בִירוּשָׁלַיִם?	בְּגִלְל קוֹרוֹנָה!
לְמָה אַתָּה לוֹמֵד עִבְרִית?	כִּי אֲנִי אוֹהֵב אֶת יִשְׂרָאֵל.
לְמָה אַתָּה עוֹשֶׂה אֶת זֶה?	אֲנִי לֹא יוֹדֵעַ!
לְמָה קָר הַיּוֹם?	כִּכָּה.
